

Gazelle 60cm Prix Caprilli Test

Maximum height is 30cm. It is understood that in the working gaits, a jumping horse is not expected to be as round on the bit as a competing dressage horse. The horse must softly accept the bit and may show more "roundness" in the parts of the test separate from the jumps. Trot work to be done posting.

Transition in and out of the halt may be through the walk.

All tests are ridden in 60x20m arena.

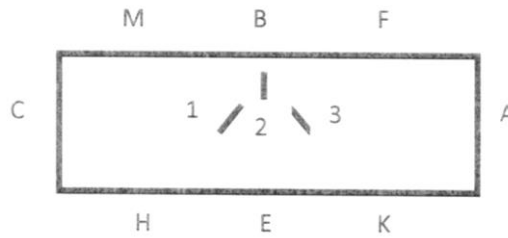
Average time to complete is 5mins.

Max Points 250

Test may be called (-15points).

Errors of Course = 1st -2points, 2nd -4points, 3rd -8points, 4th = Elimination

Errors Jumping = knockdown -2points, 1st refusal -4points, 2nd refusal -4, 3rd refusal = elimination.



Jump# 2, 2m from B #1 and #3 on angle from #2 so not in path of centre line.
